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Dear Parents and Carers

Welcome back everyone! We hope you all had a great break and feel ready to embrace the lead up to our seasonal celebrations! This is an exciting term and staff have been working hard to plan an engaging topic based curriculum, leading to an open afternoon for you in December.

We would like to welcome Mrs Uren to the team. Mrs Uren will be working in the office every day from 8am-4pm this term and has already implemented a number of systems to support us with managing school payments. We are in the middle of getting all invoices up to date and moving to an electronic system. Thank you parents for bearing with us during this transition period.

Please note: there will be no clubs on Wednesday 7th and Thursday 8th November due to Parent Consultations taking place on both days. You will be receiving your child's ten minute appointment time by Wednesday this week. Please let us know if you cannot make your allotted time. School will be finishing at the earlier time of 2.00pm on Thursday 8th November. If your child usually stays for FUNZONE on a Thursday, you will automatically have a place reserved at no extra charge. Please contact the office before Thursday, if you need to reserve a Funzone place 2.00-3.10.

We have lots of lost property clothing! On Friday 2nd November, clothing will be displayed in the playground at the end of the day. We urge parents to ensure items of clothing are labelled so we can quickly return them to you.

This week, you will be receiving an attendance 'traffic light' letter to inform you of your child's attendance percentage. We need to work together to make quick improvements as our whole school **Attendance** from last year was considerably below the National expectations of 96.5%. For this first half term we are already below expectations at 94.3% - which is over 600 absences. As a school, we want to be supportive of exceptional circumstances and will always consider your unique family circumstances. The Governing Body will be monitoring attendance closely and reviewing our policy in order to improve the attendance of every child and therefore remove gaps in learning. The good news is that our punctuality has greatly improved and we would like to thank you for supporting us with this as it makes a huge difference to the whole school community- enabling our morning to run smoothly.
