EMERGENCY CHILDCARE FOR VULNERABLE CHILDREN AND CRITICAL KEY WORKERS

Thank you for informing school of your critical key worker role. You are now on the school's critical register and any communication regarding the school's partial opening will be sent to you directly.

This will be reviewed daily and weekly in line with advice from the government – please contact the school by email if your circumstances change.

Please understand that this provision is only for children who are unable to safely stay at home with another family member. Your child will be at greater risk of exposure to the virus by being at school due to the close proximity of front line workers' children.

You will receive an email every Friday to confirm arrangements for the following week and days that we are open according to demand.

We have put in strict measures to protect staff, children and families from the spread of infection:

- Parents will not be allowed into the school building.
- Weekly Application form needs to be completed and returned by email.
- 3 emergency contact numbers are essential.
- Children will be met by the provision leader at the side of the school hall entrance at 8.55 am not before.
- Children will wash their hands as soon as they enter the school building. *This will be repeated throughout the day and before handing the children back to you.*
- We will be ensuring appropriate social distancing measures during provision this includes children and staff and will involve your child having their own desk.
- All children will be required to **bring in:**

packed lunch, mid-morning snack and water bottle pencil case own mini hand gel bottle- if you have available tissues ready in pocket reading book own game/activity (optional) — for quiet time

- **Children should not wear school uniform** – children should come to school in warm clothes suitable for the outdoors – including hats and gloves if your child feels the cold – as we are aiming to spend time outside throughout the day.

If your child is returning the following day – please ensure they have a change of clean clothes.
