

Our School

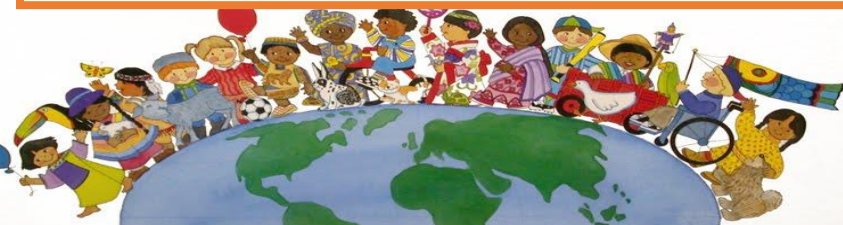
