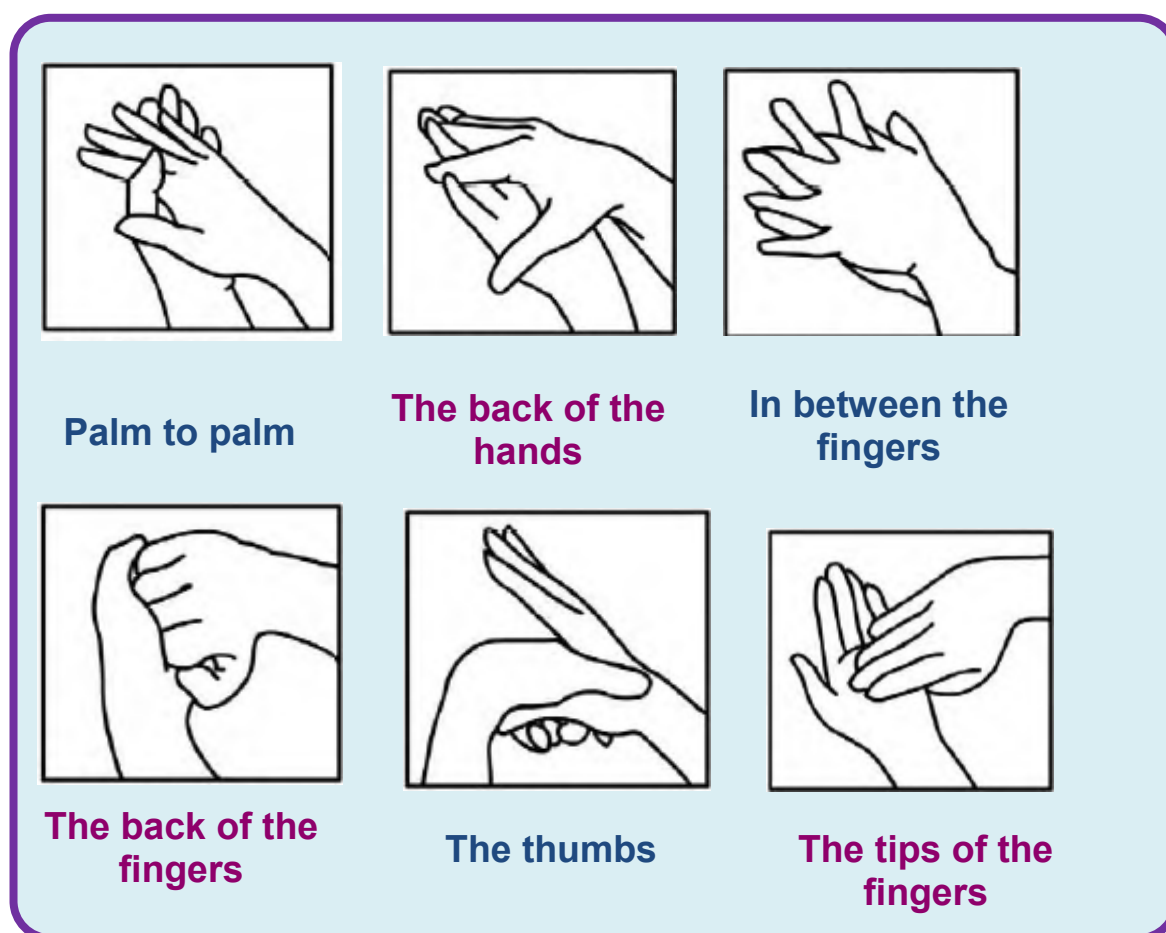




Dear Families
