The Big Brush Club- NHS Supervised Tooth Brushing Programme

As a school, we have been enrolled to provide daily supervised tooth brushing for your child during the school day. This NHS scheme is brought to us by Big Brush Club and our aim is to get children in Jade Class brushing during school time to help tackle tooth decay. Children will be supervised during the brushing sessions every day and will be under the guidance of trained 'Oral Health Champions'. Each child will receive their own toothbrush, which will be easily identifiable and will be stored in a safe storage system. It is important children continue to brush their teeth at home, with a fluoride toothpaste. To support this, we are sending children home with their own pack which includes a toothbrush, toothpaste and information leaflet.

Please also let me know of any allergies or health issues your child may have which could mean they are unable to take part in the scheme.
