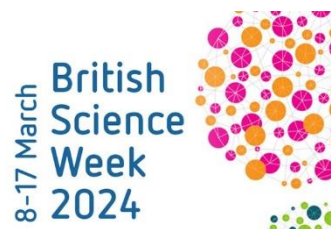


Hello everyone,
