Dear Parent/Carer

As part of our Adventure learning week, all of KS2 are going on an adventure!

On **Friday 28th June** KS2 children and adults will be walking from **The Fox and Hound Scorrier**, to Portreath beach.

We will be appreciating our beautiful local area while thinking about keeping fit, healthy and safe in the outdoors, as well as enjoying spending time together walking from The Fox and Hound Scorrier along the old tram way to Portreath beach.

To help make this a great day for all, children need to be dropped to The Fox and Hound car park for 9.10 am (allowing time for sibling drop offs), where the children will be registered.

They will then need picking up from Portreath Beach – Lifeguard hut, at **2.30pm**, allowing time for sibling pick up.

The children do not need to wear uniform, but it is **essential that they have suitable footwear** – no flipflops. The children will be carrying their own lunch, so a rucksack will be needed.

With our Cornish weather being so unpredictable, please bring sun hat, sun cream and a coat of some sort.

We will be meeting the RNLI life guards at the beach, where they will give all children safety reminders about being near the sea and on the beach, and then have the chance to paddle, so a towel and swim wear would be advisable if your child would like to go in the sea.

Packed lunch and a bottle of water are vital, as the walk will take most of the morning and we will be making regular water and snack stops!

All medication, especially inhalers must be given to the office or class teacher before the trip. If your child attends breakfast club or Funzone, school will transport them by mini bus to The Fox and Hound and back to school after the day to attend Funzone as normal.

In order for the day to be as successful as possible, it is **vital** that teachers and your child know who is picking them up from Portreath beach. Please indicate clearly on the attached form – sharing lifts is a great idea as parking is a little limited!
