This week, Emerald class will begin their Spring learning in earnest. Our focus is Ancient Egypt. This will run through a number of curriculum areas including literacy, comprehension, history, design and technology and art. The children have already been introduced to the pyramids at Giza, hieroglyphics and the pharaoh Tutankhamun. So far, they have all enthusiastically engaged with the subject so hopefully they'll continue to enjoy and excel as we continue to delve into the fascinating world of the Egyptians.

During this term, the children will write a narrative based on Marcy and the Riddle of the Sphinx and a non-chronological report on the River Nile. In maths, our focus will be on multiplication and division. Please encourage your child to access TTRockstars daily. It's a great platform for multiplication practise and will ensure your child is ready for the statutory multiplication check test in June. In Science, we will study forces and magnets. I will send out a curriculum overview this week detailing other areas of learning.

This exciting opportunity will take place on the evening of the 7th February with your child performing as part of our class - on stage at the Regal Theatre. Please keep this evening free! The children are excited to receive their karate reading bands and it is something they are all working towards.
