- PHONICS WORKSHOP FOR PARENTS Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> February 9.15-10.00

- **BREAKFAST CLUB** If your child requires breakfast, 8.30 is the latest time to arrive.
- **SAFEGUARDING** Parents should not be entering the building unless a meeting with the teacher has been arranged and you have signed in via the office. Please do not leave the door open for other parents or children to go through. Thank you.
- **OFFICE RECEPTION** This is a small space, please use the playground to wait and meet up with friends. Receptionists are finding it difficult to take important phone calls.
- 3.10 and 4.00 COLLECTIONS Please collect your children on time. If you are late, then your child will be sent to FUNZONE at a cost of £4.00. FUNZONE is still running at a loss as parents are not booking places ahead of time or children are being collected late which means we have to pay for an extra adult to stay. Please support us with this so we can keep FUNZONE running as a viable option.
- EWO EDUCATION WELFARE OFFICER is in school during the next two weeks monitoring 'lates' and unauthorised absences. Your child's attendance – including 'minutes late' each day, will be reviewed and you will be contacted regarding any concerns.
- COMMUNICATION We try very hard to send important information out in advance in addition to the year overview leaflet. The newsletter contains important information and reminders. Please take time to read the newsletter where you will find all the latest information. We realise there is a problem with letters sometimes not making it to you. Please note that all letters sent home are on the website. In order to aid better communication we are trialling a new email system, which you can set up directly to your phone.

**EMAIL REMINDER SYSTEM NOW UP AND RUNNING** - We are now sending reminders by email and hope to move to this system for all letters and newsletters. This is a cost efficient way for the school to send messages rather than by phone text messages. Please make sure school emails go straight to your inbox.
