The teaching staff of **St Day and Carharrack School** would like to meet with **all** classes on-line using ZOOM. Teachers will email you a link, time and day individually, for the week beginning 22nd June 2020. This is purely optional but a great way to connect enabling everyone to meet and see their friends together at last!

You will be sent the link and instructions in an email **from your class teacher**. The device will need a camera and microphone.

When you log in it will tell the teacher you are waiting to enter the meeting and then, as the organiser of the group, we can give you permission to enter. **It will be by invite only and a closed group.** You will need to make sure it has your child's name as the display name.

It may take a while to check the video and audio are working. If you cannot be heard or seen, click on the mute and video button which will help you enable the camera and microphone. These can be found to the bottom left hand corner when you have Zoom open as a full screen. Alternatively you will be able to put a message in the chat bar that the teacher can then help you with.

Once we have greeted everyone, we would like each child to share something interesting they have done or achieved during lockdown. We will use this first session as more of a 'hello' and enjoying seeing everyone! The following week there will then be a planned activity set by each individual teacher. Activities may include games, class quiz, stories or anything else the children may suggest!

Obviously, this is a new way for us to support your children while not in school and I believe it is a good way in supporting emotional wellbeing for all. There may be technical hiccups but don't worry we will talk you through any issues. It is vital everyone adheres and supports the privacy of others and by accepting the offer you are accepting to participate in being mindful that no permission is given to distribute, take or record imagery.
