It is with tremendous excitement that we can share with you the details for the Year 6 residential trip.

This year, we are focussing on the outdoors and will be travelling to Porthpean Outdoor Centre in St Austell to take part in a great range of activities which will be brilliant! Porthpean Outdoor Education Centre is located just outside St Austell and specialises in outdoor and adventurous activities for children and young people. Our children will be encouraged to take on challenges and learn a range of new skills safely. The Centre has its own onsite indoor climbing wall and outdoor high ropes course and is skilled and equipped to provide water-based and land-based outdoor activities. The key values of the centre are safety, learning and fun. Staff are fully qualified to run each activity and DBS checks are held by all team members.

We understand there is an enormous amount of trust involved in enabling this to happen. As this will be a 'first' for some of our children, we would like to assure you that the highest health and safety precautions are taken and risk assessments completed. We are monitoring the coronavirus and will follow Public Health England advice if the situation changes in Cornwall. Our priority is to ensure your children are safe at all times.
