Activity of the week to try at home!




Chalk letters on the fence

RWInc sounds learnt: masdtlpnpgockubhlfrjvwquyzx

We have completed all the 'single' set one sounds! Now we are learning 'special friends sh, ch, th, ng, nk'. Once we have done these letter sounds we will begin Set 2 sounds. Children are beginning to take home sound blending books to read with you at home. Please let them share these with you at home. Don't forget to record this on BOOM READER. This can be as simple as —"Heard H read" or "Used sounds fluently and quickly to read easily".
