Roblox concerns

Thank you to those of you that have shared their recent concerns about the game 'Roblox'. Recently, it has been reported in the news about a potential biometric location tracking feature which is believed to disclose players' addresses. Some players have also reported 'strange' messages appearing on their device. Therefore, I would highly urge that you follow the recommendations below to keep your child safe online:

- Maintain an open line of communication with your child about their online activities. Encourage them to share their experiences and any concerns they may have.
- Teach children about the risks of sharing personal information online and the importance of maintaining privacy in digital spaces.
- Implement parental control tools and privacy settings on devices and online platforms to monitor and restrict inappropriate content.
- Establish clear rules about internet usage, including time limits and permissible websites, to foster a balanced and healthy online experience.
- Keep yourself updated on the latest online trends and potential threats to better guide and protect your children.
