#### **Our Brilliant Nurture Provision**


As part of this series of half term newsletters, we continue to look at the support and provision on offer in our nurture provision. This week - Superflex!



Superflex is a group intervention which helps children to:

- Develop their social observation and awareness
- Increase flexibility of thought
- Take different perspectives

The intervention uses characters who have different powers to better understand the importance of healthy, reciprocal social communication. Superflex is our character who can empathise and interact with others. We also meet 'Rock Brain' who finds it difficult to step outside their own thoughts.


